There are a total of 114 stars in the whole of the Stargate system. They can be divided into 5 categories.

The 14 grade A stars

The 14 grade B stars

The 4 catalysts

The 34 grade C stars

The 48 grade D stars

Moreover, for the ease of interpretation, we need only to study the nature of the 14 grade A stars and 14 grade B stars in different chambers at different houses to give a good interpretation of the pictures in different aspects of life.

The 14 Grade A Stars

These stars called Grade A stars reveal their immense energy that they carry and also account for the wide spectrum of nature that contains in each star describing the personality of the individual when placed in the Self Chamber.

The Emperor

The most important star that gives the Emperor's Stargate its name. This star displays all the qualities of a strong, wise, courageous monarch – a natural, pioneering leader who looks at the big picture. The Emperor in the Self enhances longevity. At its zenith, a brilliant Emperor would bestow prosperity and banish evil. In fact, it is so strong that it accommodates rather than eradicates. For example, the Killing Stars (Ram, Spinning Top, Fire, Bell, Void, Punishment) can all be altered, and become strengthening forces, by the presence of a brilliant Emperor. It displays power and elegance and commands respect. Having all the qualities of self-confidence and leadership, many will be mesmerized by this individual. This magnetism can therefore, also manifest itself as sexual attraction.



Zi Wei / The Emperor is the star of all stars. Its imperial supremacy lies in both its authoritative power and the capacity for mercy. The Emperor in the Spouse Chamber indicates a decent and responsible spouse. Nevertheless, there is a hint of loneliness, which might be expressed in the form of incompatible aspirations between the husband and wife, sharing very little time together in life or solitude in old age. There is also a strong tendency for a dominant spouse that demands absolute submission of the partner. People with strong stars in the Spouse Chamber (such as the Emperor-General and the Emperor-Opportunity combinations) and less powerful stars in the Life Chamber will often encounter commanding partners. Make spiritual compatibility the priority in choosing a marital partner. Sharing the same passion and goals in life can harness the inherent solitude in the nature of the Emperor and sustain a loving relationship even if the couple do not have much time together.



The Intelligence

A balanced, strong mind breeds a kind leader who is calm but motivated. Intelligence here would ensure a quick mind and agility. His thirst for knowledge is contagious and many will be intrigued by his unique thoughts and ideas. His strength lies in being challenged by obstacles and will not be felled by difficulties. Alas, intrigued by anything that's a challenge, he may be stalled by minute details. The Intelligence stands for change – not upheavals in life but the flow of thoughts and changes in the physical location. In other words, the Intelligence represents adaptability and flexibility.

This star is a strategist by nature and is mechanically inclined. Because of this nature, he may be perceived as blunt and insensitive. Once he overcomes this challenge, success will be easy.



A Spouse Chamber ruled by the Intelligence signifies a life partner with delicate and sensitive emotions – sometimes too sensitive, nevertheless often artistic and creative. The mutable nature of the Intelligence makes it an indiscreet decision maker. The following situations may arise: a thought of 'better someone than no one'; not caring for the formality of the relationship; the spouse might not have a stable or desirable career or is keen on speculation and wager.

In years and decades of good luck, people of this constellation may go with the flow and get married without too much consideration. There is however a chance for the change of mind, leading to a breakup of the relationship, causing a late marriage in life. In as much as there is no Killing Star present in the Self and Spouse Chamber, the Intelligence in the Spouse Chamber often leads to early marriage and many relationships are love at first sight. Therefore there will be a considerable number of changes, big and small, in the marriage.

The 14 Grade B Stars

The grade B stars as it is called is lower in its energy compared to the Grade A stars and also more simple in its nature. Yet as governed by either its dark or bright stars category, their presence in the Self chamber governs whether one is lucky or dodgy in their life path ahead.

The Bright Stars

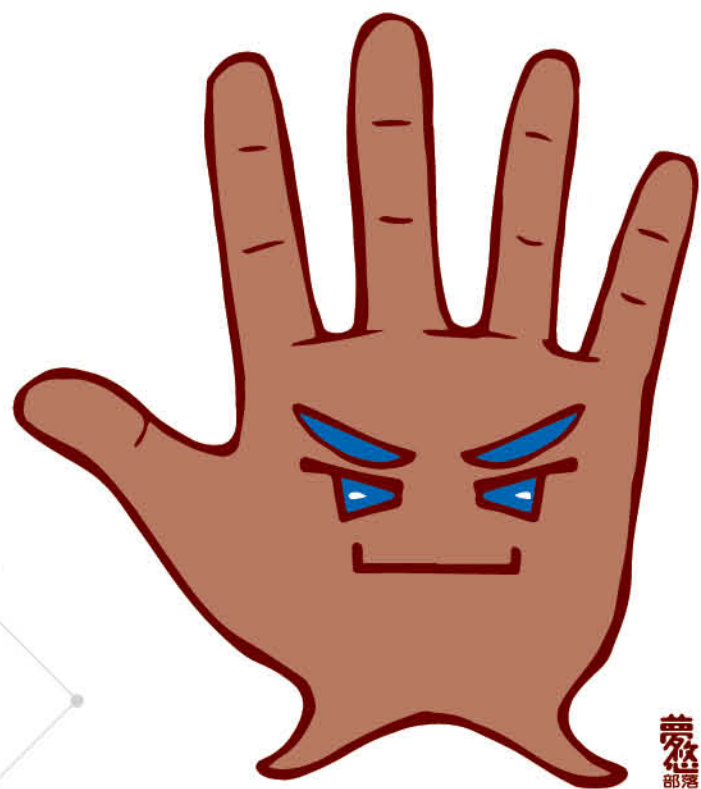

If set right by the brilliant, auspicious stars, they enhance their wonderful powers, making for an even more successful sector. Should these find themselves in the presence of the evil or major stars in retrograde, they have the power to weaken the damage. The Dark Stars

A Dark Star sharing the same sector with a Brilliant is unfortunate, as it would have the power to deplete any fine characteristics the Brilliant might bring. If latched onto a weak major star, they have the power to poison. Alas, these dark stars are a necessity in life's journey as it is through these murky days that we learn the most. We are then propelled to greater success. In your darkest hours, remember this: Our worst enemies are in fact our greatest teachers.

The Left Minister



If found in the Self Chamber, either of the Left or Right Ministers will be handsome, beautiful or distinguished looking. The personality will be easy going, gracious, supportive, understanding and kind. He will be striving for the best – literally reaching for the stars. Always the optimist, he can safely see himself through any crisis. However, he needn't worry too much about bad luck – he has the innate ability to ward this off. This is one star which possesses the most karmic wealth. Acceptance being one of his trademarks, the Left Minister takes hard work and responsibility in his stride and will be kept busy. The Left Minister enhances all the other stars. However, should he meet up with a dark Ram, Fire, or Bell, his powers will be dimmed. The Left Minister's one weakness will be brought to the fore if placed in the Spouse's sector. A rocky marriage, for sure – should it be teamed with dark or evil stars.



The Left Minister in the Spouse Chamber symbolizes a life partner of decent appearance and modest and generous nature with active and positive personality. The setting makes a loving couple. The co-presence of any of the six Auspicious Stars and the Wealth , Power  and Fame  catalysts signifies a partner with great achievement in career, enormous ability in work and a broad social network. However, the presence of any of the Six Killing Stars or Obstacle  catalyst in the Life or Karmic Chamber will put marriage in the shade; in an unfavorable ten-year luck, the marriage may suffer from unexpected turns.

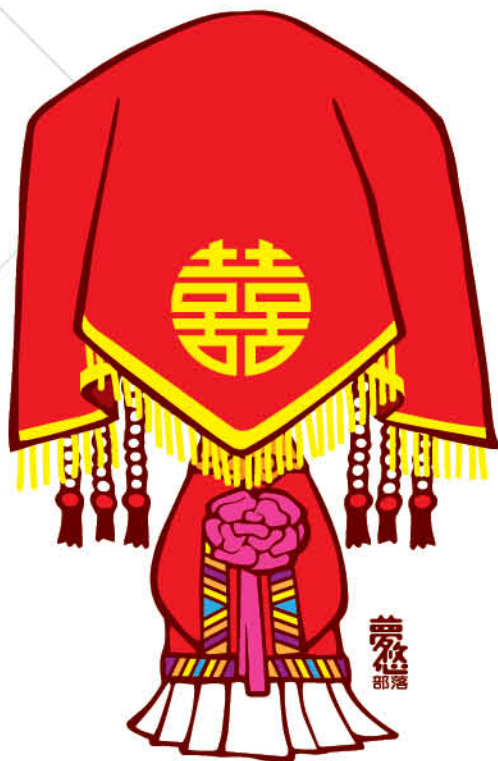
The Right Minister



The other supporting arm to the Emperor, this is a Glowing star with qualities very similar to The Left Minister. If found in the Self Chamber, the person will be handsome, beautiful or distinguished looking. The personality will be easy going, gracious, supportive, understanding and kind. Its powers are, however, dimmer than that of the Left Minister and with a major difference – it trails matters of the sexual or seductive kind. However, associations brought on by this star do not last. Accept the pain as part and parcel. Watch out for a pairing up with The Scholar, The Waif, Intelligence, The Messenger or The Commander in the same house, its opposite or at 120°. Such a liaison spells disaster of the romantic kind – a relationship doomed to end, but not without its long drawn out theatrics first of all. The Right Minister in the Spouse sector indicates incompatibility, sadness and upheavals, finally ending in separation.



With the Right Minister alone in the Spouse Chamber, the person will have a life partner with an appealing look, a warm and respectable character with easy-going and generous manner. The life partner is by nature very optimistic even in the time of hardship. Therefore, this is a peach-blossom star – one that has a good tendency to attract admirers. If the setting of the Life and Karmic Chamber is not pleasant, there might be ups and downs in the marriage, extra-marital affairs or the situation of two women serving one man. As long as the Life Chamber setting is favourable, this constellation suggests a bright and honest spouse and a peaceful relationship.

The Happiness

Love stars

These love stars (Grade C star) will lead you to your chart with their accurately predicted milestones. The milestones in the various years of one life are indicative of major events: one's marriage, or an important relationship, the arrival of children etc.

The Lover and The Happiness

These enchanted stars The Lover/Happiness (C30) always form a pair with each other at its opposite house; i.e. if, for example, the Lover is found in the Self House, for sure Happiness would be in the Travel Sector, its opposite. The Lover signifies betrothal, whilst Happiness brings its crystallization a newborn. Sometimes, therefore, only one or the other, is shown. With either of these residing in Self, we will be blessed with physical beauty. During childhood, we would have received a lot of affection, then grow up to be very attractive, even in the face of a Killing Star in the same house or opposite. The Lover (C31) and ruler of marriage, would be most influential when it enters the Current year Self or Karmic Sector. Combined with an Auspicious Star and one of the stable majors e.g. the Mirror or Vault these will be the times for tying the knot. Should Happiness fall into the Minors Sector, that would be indicative of a childbirth. However, be wary should either of these romantic stars meet up with an unstable major (such as Intelligence) or a Killing Star. This would indicate unfruitful or illicit romance.

Because these two stars are so closely interrelated, and stars in opposing houses always relate to each other, the betrothal/newborn factors can be cross-referenced with surrounding stars. The Lover and its surrounding stars can relate to the unborn child; and Happiness and its sisters can point to events surrounding the lovers. The Lover does well with the Literary Minister or the Arts Minister at 120° both sides (beginning with where the Lover is as the first house, count to the fourth house) as being most auspiciously placed conducive to a happy relationship. For those who are unattached, this star combination brings an engagement, betrothal or the beginning of a new, committed relationship. This star of betrothal, however, forms an uneasy alliance if met up by her flirtatious friends e.g. Crimson and Opportunity. Watch out for a clandestine affair in the brewing.
